

There have been some more changes to how we do things at church now that our state has reached the 90% fully vaccinated mark.

Firstly, the **fully vaccinated** can sing, but all of us still need to wear a **mask**. Secondly, limits have dropped from 1 person per 4 m² to 1 person per 2 m². This is good news for our small groups and for funerals, but a reminder that the 1.5m distance requirement between households still remains.

It is really difficult for us to share the Lord's Supper whilst we are still required to wear masks, however we should be able to resume the Lord's Supper by Christmas. We do not expect to resume the Wednesday Communion service at St. Paul's until 2022.

Finally, those on email have received a letter from Bishop Peter about our new volunteer policies. Printed copies are available on the back table. Please pray for us as we begin to implement the new policy.

SRE (Special Religious Education)

We have six Primary schools in our Parish's geographical area (Avoca, Brisbania, Copacabana, Empire Bay, Kincumber and Pretty Beach), where we teach SRE.

NEWS FROM OUR SRE CO-ORDINATOR, TRISH SKEHAN

This week Trish has been advised by our schools that there is no way to run SRE classes within the Covid/cohort/class guidelines and therefore SRE will not be returning this year.

Normally classes for each year have been joined together for SRE. However, under Covid safe guidelines, this would not be possible. For example, one of the schools has 4 different kindergarten classes and the children in these classes would have to do everything just with their own cohort. This would mean that each class would have to be taught separately and would require 3 more SRE teachers.

Trish has asked each school to convey to our students how disappointed we are not to be able to see them before Christmas, but that we look forward to returning next year.

Pray for the children who would normally be attending SRE that somehow, as Christmas draws near, they will hear the good news of their Saviour's birth.

Pray for SRE teachers in their disappointment at not being able to teach this term.

Pray that the schools will be able to welcome back SRE teachers in 2022. Pray for Trish and all who those in our diocese who co-ordinate SRE, as they seek to find ways of continuing to teach SRE to children in schools.

The Fifth of the Signs

- Jesus is Lord over His creation

John 6:14-21 (NIV)

¹⁴ After the people saw the sign Jesus performed, they began to say, "Surely this is the Prophet who is to come into the world." ¹⁵ Jesus, knowing that they intended to come and make him king by force, withdrew again to a mountain by himself.

¹⁶ When evening came, his disciples went down to the lake, ¹⁷ where they got into a boat and set off across the lake for Capernaum. By now it was dark, and Jesus had not yet joined them. ¹⁸ A strong wind was blowing and the waters grew rough. ¹⁹ When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus approaching the boat, walking on the water; and they were frightened. ²⁰ But he said to them, "It is I; don't be afraid." ²¹ Then they were willing to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat reached the shore where they were heading.
